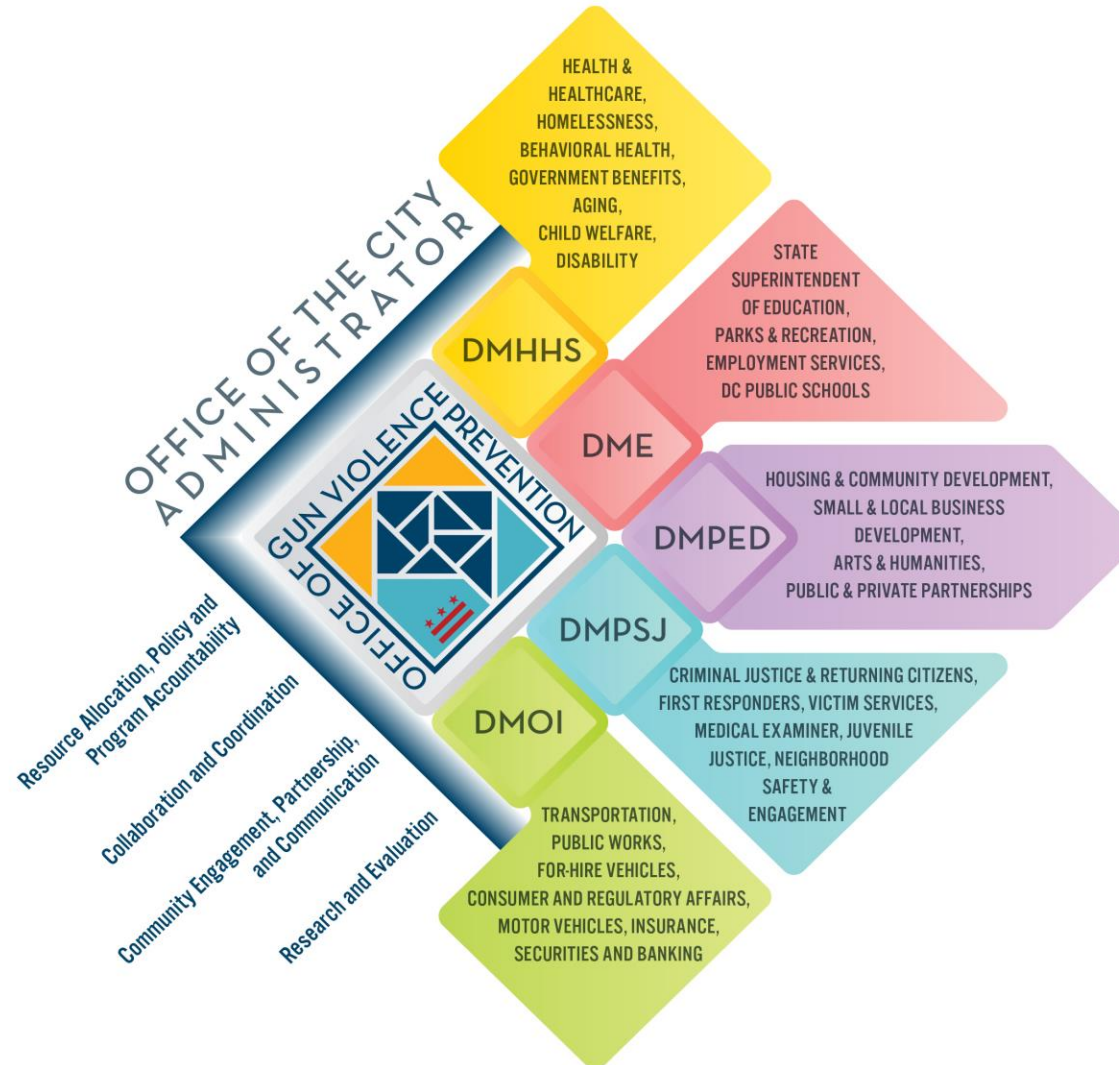

- Mini grants are:
  - awarded to individuals and CBOs
  - awarded in the amount of \$5k or \$15k
  - used to conduct programs/ events in the following categories
    - Community Wealth
    - Community Revitalization
    - Community Healing
  - monitored by OGVP Grant Monitors/  
Credible Messengers

\$2.6M for 282 community grants

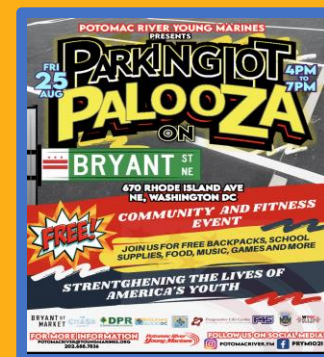

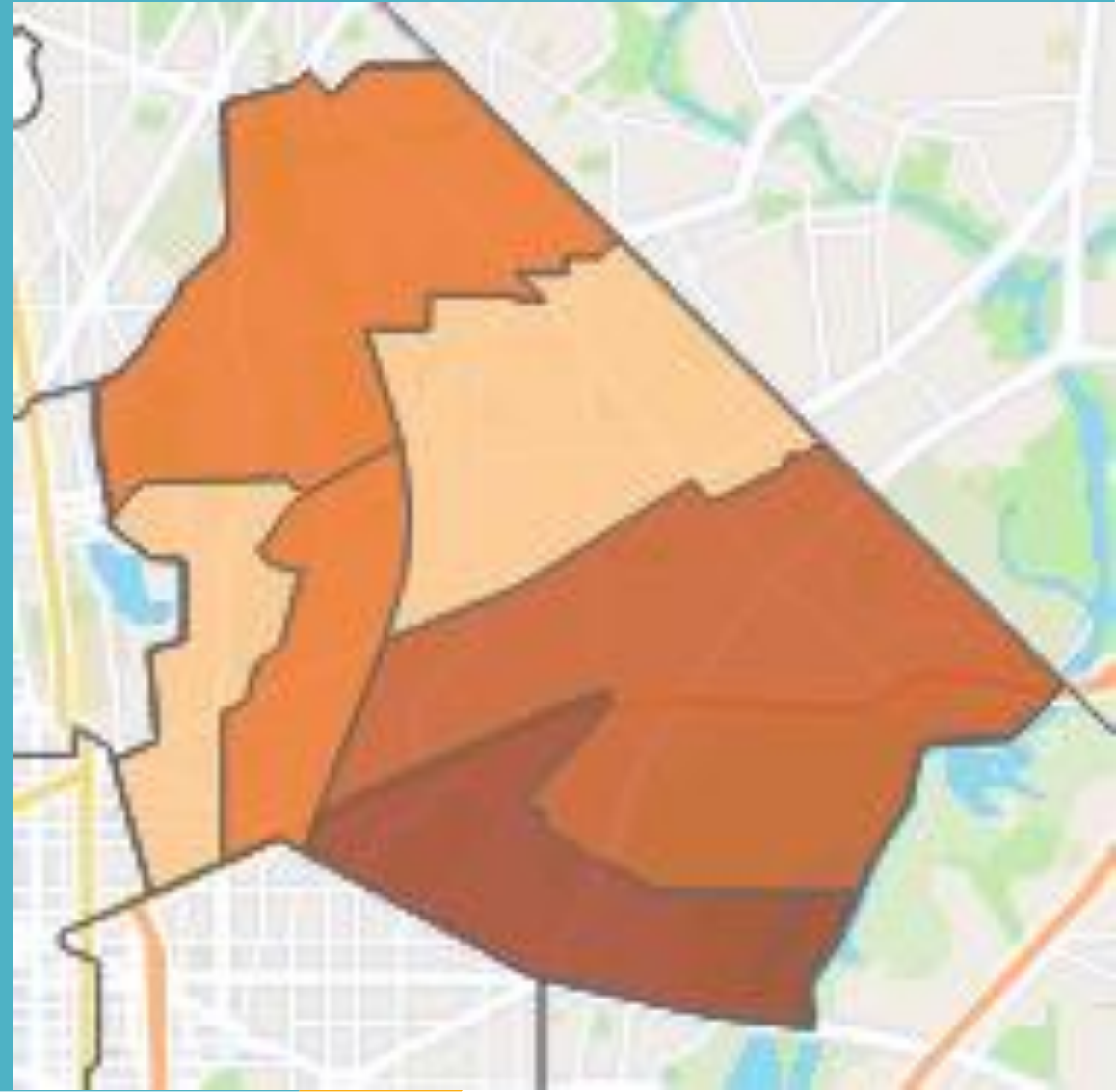

# Highlights, Vulnerabilities, Issues

## FIFTH DISTRICT

### Major Challenges

Robberies and Carjackings

- Robberies and Carjackings 1% increase YTD but was down 21% in February

Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT)

- MVT 7 % increase YTD

Homicides

- Up 17% YTD (6 to 7 in Fifth District; **in just Ward 5, homicides are at same level as last year, 6 and 6**).
  - 4 are closed
  - 5 were inside locations
