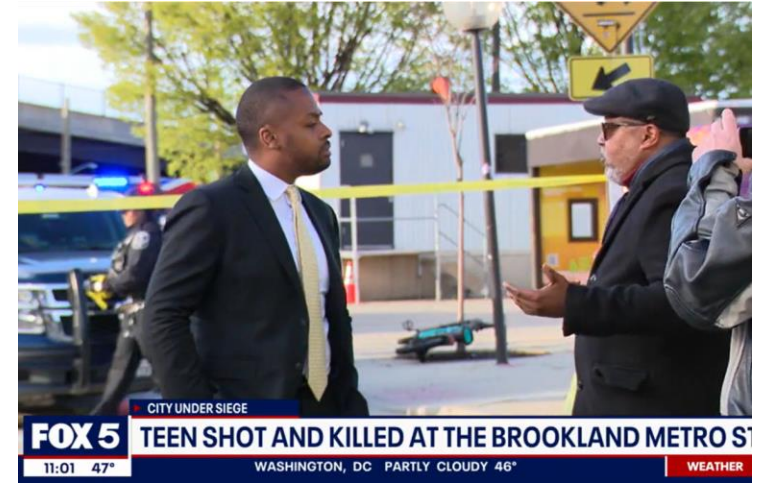

Major Challenges

Robberies and Carjackings

- Robberies and Carjackings **14%** decrease YTD; down **67%** in April

Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT)

- MVT **4 %** increase YTD down **20%** in April

Homicides

- Down **27%**
 - 5 are closed
 - 5 were inside locations

- Increased **10%** YTD

Budget Considerations for Public Safety in FY25

Highlights of Mayor's proposal

- Funds MPD's requested hiring level and sustains Safe Passage, violence interrupter, and victims' services programs with local dollars to replace expiring federal funds
- Dedicated funding for school security upgrades (locks, fences, cameras)
- \$1 million to hire more 911 call takers and dispatchers
- 200 more CCTV cameras in FY25, with 200 additional cameras each year throughout the financial plan with goal of having 1,025 cameras in place by 2028.
- 47 new license plate readers to assist with tracking carjacked and stolen vehicles

Additional work needed

- Ensuring that our safe passage programs target locations of real need, including advocating for the expansion of the program to Brookland and Fort Totten metro stations
- Implementing proposals advanced by the school safety committee, including an HSEMA alert system for school communities and role clarification requirements
- Investing in a trust-building center on North Capitol Street to ensure individuals needing addiction treatment and other supports get the help they deserve
